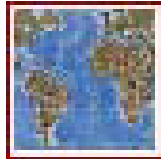


The Zora Neale Hurston Plays Collection

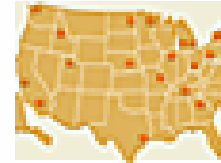

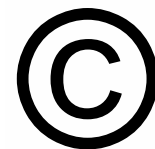


Edward S. Curtis: North American Indian Collection
